## Art: The Iconic Art of Flyin

As a beer fan, you are probably familiar with the beers of Flying Dog Brewery, founded in 1990 in Aspen, CO, but brewed exclusively in Maryland since 2008, Flying Dog features some of the most distinctive label art in the beer industry.

The work is that of British artist Ralph Steadman (b. 1936) who is most famous for illustrating the literary work of Hunter S. Thompson, though his work has actually appeared in many magazines and books. It was Steadman's illustration of Thompson's coverage of the Kentucky Derby in 1969 that helped launch the pair to fame. Indeed, Steadman is as much credited with founding gonzo journalism as Thompson is.

Steadman has been drawing professionally since 1956 and has been doing label art for Flying Dog since the mid-1990s, when he was introduced to Flying Dog by Thompson himself, who had become
